

## What Is the Actual Cost of a Back Injury?

The following example presents scenarios of possible costs incurred when an employee suffers an injury.

Employee	Medical Expenses	Lost Days	Daily Wage	Restricted Days	Salary Compensation (2/3 Wage * # Lost Days)	Replacement Staff Cost for Lost Days (Wage * Lost Days)	Transitional Duty Staff Cost (Wage for 2 empl. * # of Restricted Days)	Total
CNA (back injury)	\$18,000.00	25	\$72.00	64	\$1,188.00	\$1,800.00	\$9,216.00	\$30,204.00
RN (back injury)	\$40,000.00	60	\$150.00	30	\$5,940.00	\$9,000.00	\$9,000.00	\$63,940.00
CNA (shoulder inj.)	\$9,000.00	15	\$72.00	120	\$712.80	\$1,080.00	\$17,280.00	\$28,072.80
RN (shoulder inj.)	\$2,000.00	3	\$150.00	22	\$297.00	\$450.00	\$6,600.00	\$9,347.00
